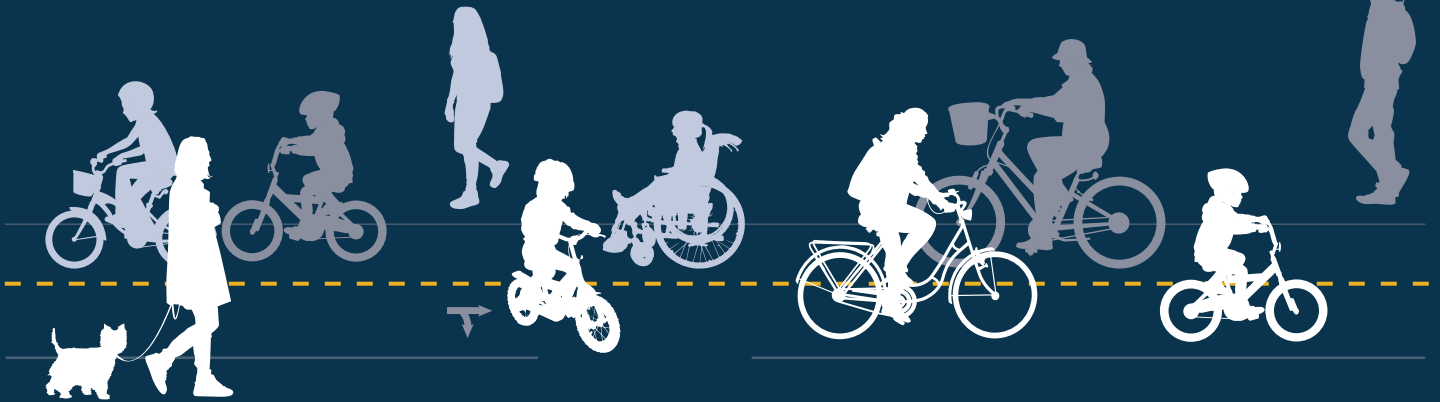


Traffic Gardens are...

What are traffic gardens?

Traffic gardens are mini roadways with painted or chalked lines. They are built in safe places so children can learn and practice safe biking and walking skills. These skills can lead to safe driving skills and awareness of others on the road.
